**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act to promote alcohol storage space.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 20 of Chapter 138 as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended
2 by inserting after line 37 the following:

3 An establishment licensed under section fifteen of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight is
4 hereby permitted under this section to store its licensed alcoholic beverages in a licensed and
5 bonded warehouse. Said licensee shall only be permitted to use the hereinabove described stored
6 licensed alcoholic beverages on such licensee's premises in the normal course of business and
7 such licensed alcoholic beverages shall not be for resale to other establishments licensed under
8 this chapter.
