An Act relative to community radiological emergency response funds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 5K of Chapter 111 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:

3 The licensee of each existing and proposed nuclear power plant in the Commonwealth,  
4 shall fully fund offsite radiological emergency response expenses incurred by the  
5 Commonwealth or a municipality post closure until all the reactor's spent fuel is removed from  
6 the spent fuel pool and placed in dry casks. No monies from any Decommissioning Trust Fund  
7 shall be used to satisfy this obligation.
