*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1. Chapter 94G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following new section:—

3 Section 3 ½ . Transparency in the Siting of Marijuana Facilities

5 (a) All cities and towns in the Commonwealth shall adhere to the same process for  
6 approving the Host Community Agreement notwithstanding the results of the vote in the  
7 statewide referendum.
