An Act providing for concurrent jurisdiction at certain Massachusetts Port Authority properties.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 110 of chapter 205 of the Acts of 1996 is hereby amended by  
2 striking out the words “and Massachusetts port authority properties” in the first sentence and  
3 replacing in place thereof the following words:- and other Massachusetts port authority  
4 properties dedicated exclusively to aviation operations and shall have concurrent police authority  
5 with the local police force in all other Massachusetts port authority properties in Boston.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
