An Act prohibiting certain fees connected to rental cars.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32E <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as amended by section 4 of chapter  
2 368 of the acts of 2018, is hereby further amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section to the contrary, a rental car company may  
4 not charge an upfront fee or surcharge to a renter to account for the potential payment or  
5 collection of tolls.
