An Act ensuring the efficiency of protective order hearings.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2 of Chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-

3           In the event that the plaintiff and defendant are currently before the probate court on  
4 matters including but not limited to: divorce; separation; paternity; custody; support; and  
5 alimony, proceedings under this chapter shall be filed, heard, and determined in the probate court  
6 where said matter or matters are pending.
