**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to the membership of the conservation commission of the town of Holliston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 8C of chapter 40 of the General Laws, the board
2 of selectmen of the town of Holliston may appoint not more than 2 alternate members of the
3 conservation commission of the town to serve staggered terms not to exceed 3 years.

4 The chair of the conservation commission may designate an alternate member to sit on
5 the commission in the case of absence, inability to act or conflict of interest on the part of a
6 member of the commission or, in the event of a vacancy on the conservation commission, until
7 the vacancy is filled pursuant to said section 8C of said chapter 40.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
