Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The second paragraph of section 1D of chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2016 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "suppliers", in line 38,
- 3 the following words:-; provided, however, that such non-utility competitive suppliers shall not
- 4 directly contact prospective residential customers at home or by telephone except upon the
- 5 customer's request.
