An Act relative to certain professional licensure training requirements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 87V of chapter 112 the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph the following paragraph: –

3           Sections 87T to 87KK, inclusive, shall not apply to the following persons while in the  
4 proper discharge of their professional duties: persons who dry, style, arrange, dress, curl, hot iron  
5 or shampoo and condition hair if the service does not include applying reactive chemicals to  
6 permanently straighten, curl or alter the structure of the hair and if the person takes and  
7 completes a class relating to sanitation, infection protection and law review that is provided by  
8 the board or its designee. This paragraph does not apply if a person is engaging in the practice of  
9 aesthetics or cosmetology. A person who is exempt pursuant to this paragraph shall post a sign in  
10 a conspicuous location in the person's place of business notifying the public that the person's  
11 services are not regulated by the board.
