An Act relative to the foundation budget's targeted local contribution.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of chapter 70 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by adding the following 2 paragraphs:

3           Any municipality with a combined effort yield of 100 per cent or greater of the fiscal year  
4 2018 foundation budget and each ensuing year, shall have in fiscal year 2020 and in each  
5 ensuing year a target maximum local contribution of no more than 82.5 per cent of its foundation  
6 budget.

7           Any municipality with a combined effort yield less than 100 per cent of the fiscal year  
8 2018 foundation budget and each ensuing year, shall have in fiscal year 2020 and in each  
9 ensuing year a target maximum local contribution of no more than 80 per cent of its foundation  
10 budget.
