An Act relative to election procedures in the City of Boston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 54 of chapter 452 of the acts of 1948 as most recently amended by
- 2 section 2.54 of chapter 376 of the acts of 1951, is hereby amended by adding the following:-
- 3 Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions, any individual duly qualified to be a candidate for an
- 4 elective office shall not be a candidate for nomination for two such elective offices at the same
- 5 municipal election.
- 6 Section 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect upon its passage.
- 7 Section 3. If any of the above sections are determined to not be constitutional under the
- 8 law, the remainder of the provisions shall remain valid.
