*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

17	plan or certificate of insurance issued, delivered or renewed within the commonwealth, which is
18	considered creditable coverage under section 1 of chapter 111M, shall provide coverage for the
19	purchase of medical use marijuana from a medical marijuana treatment center pursuant to said
20	chapter 94I.
21	SECTION 4. Chapter 176A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
22	section 8MM the following section:-
23	Section 8NN. Notwithstanding section 6 of chapter 94I, any contract between a
24	subscriber and the corporation under an individual or group hospital service plan that is
25	delivered, issued or renewed within the commonwealth shall provide coverage for the purchase
26	of medical use marijuana from a medical marijuana treatment center pursuant to said chapter 94I.
27	SECTION 5. Chapter 176B of the General laws is hereby amended by inserting after
28	section 4MM the following section:-
29	Section 4NN. Notwithstanding section 6 of chapter 94I, any subscription certificate under
30	an individual or group medical service agreement delivered, issued or renewed within the
31	commonwealth shall provide coverage for the purchase of medical use marijuana from a medical
32	marijuana treatment center pursuant to said chapter 94I.
