Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 36 of Chapter 85 of the General Laws is hereby amended in the last sentence by
- 2 striking the words, "of not less than fifty nor more than two hundred dollars." and inserting in it's
- 3 place the following text, "of one thousand dollars".
