A message from His Excellency the Governor validating a certain election in the town of Boylston (House, No. 3936). June 27, 2019.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act validating a certain election in the town of Boylston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 10 of chapter 39 of the General Laws or any other
- 2 general or special law or by-law to the contrary, the acts, proceedings and all votes cast by the
- 3 voters of the town of Boylston at the annual town election held on May 13, 2019, and all actions
- 4 taken pursuant thereto in reliance thereon, are hereby ratified, validated and confirmed in all
- 5 respects, notwithstanding any defects or omissions in the calling of said town election.
- 6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
