An Act designating a certain area in the South Boston section of the City of Boston in memory of John J. Mullen.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The Department of Conservation and Recreation shall designate at the gazebo structure,  
2   and land contained, adjacent to the World War II memorial at the Castle Island Reservation  
3   within the South Boston section of the city of Boston, in the memory of John J. Mullen. The  
4   Department shall consult with the Mullen family to design, erect, and maintain a suitable marker  
5   in compliance with the standards of the department.
