Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 19 of Chapter 23K of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the first sentence the following:-
- 3 "; provided, however, that the Commission shall have the discretionary authority to issue
- 4 a category 2 license in Region C instead of a category 1 license, but not both, should the
- 5 Commission determine that a category 2 license would better accomplish the Legislature's
- objectives as established in St. 2011, c. 194, notwithstanding the provisions of G.L. c. 23K §20
- 7 or any other general or special law to the contrary."
