An Act city of Chelsea Affordable Housing Trust Fund Board.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and provided  
2 that one year has passed following the entry of an order of foreclosure of tax title, the City of  
3 Chelsea shall have the authority to dispose of property taken for non-payment of property taxes  
4 under Chapter 60 of the General Laws by transferring such property at no cost to its Affordable  
5 Housing Trust Fund Board, and such Board shall be required to dispose of all such property  
6 solely for the purpose of expanding the stock of affordable housing within the City of Chelsea by  
7 using the procedures specified in Chapter 30B, Section 16.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as of the date of its passage.
