An Act authorizing the town of Leicester to continue the employment of Paul S. Doray.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Paul S. Doray,  
2 currently interim police lieutenant of the town of Leicester, may continue to serve in the position  
3 of police sergeant or a higher rank until August 31, 2022; provided, however, that he is mentally  
4 and physically capable of performing the duties of his office. No further deductions shall be  
5 made from the regular compensation of Paul S. Doray under chapter 32 of the General Laws for  
6 any service subsequent to August 31, 2020, and upon retirement, he shall receive a  
7 superannuation retirement allowance equal to that which he would have been entitled had he  
8 retired on that date.

9           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
