An Act providing for refrigeration apprentice licenses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 81 of Chapter 146 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the definition of “Refrigeration apprentice”,  
3 and inserting in place thereof the following:-

4           “Refrigeration apprentice,” either: (i) any registered person who is at least eighteen years  
5 of age and who is working at the business of refrigeration under the supervision of a master  
6 refrigeration technician or journeyman refrigeration technician; or (ii) any person at least sixteen  
7 years of age enrolled in a bureau approved program.
