An Act ensuring fair and full employee compensation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 1. Section 148 of Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "reasonable", in line 107, the
3	following sentence:-
4	Any employer paying wages to an employee by any means other than check or draft must

5 make check or draft options available for the paid wages without charge by deduction from the

6 face amount thereof or otherwise.
