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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court  
(2019-2020)  
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An Act providing further transparency in the siting of marijuana facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3(d) of chapter 94G of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the paragraph in line 82 the  
3   following sentence:-

4           As part of the licensing application, an applicant shall provide certified documentation  
5   confirming the adoption of the Cannabis Control Commission’s first operating principle, “to  
6   conduct all processes openly and transparently,” agreed to by the potential licensee and all  
7   participating municipal officials.
