In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Racquel Jean-Louis, an employee of the Suffolk County Sheriff's Department.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 Suffolk County Sheriff's Department shall establish a sick leave bank for Racquel Jean-Louis,
- an employee of the sheriff's department. Any employee of the Suffolk county sheriff's
- 4 department may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave
- 5 bank for use by Racquel Jean- Louis. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences
- 6 unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as
- 7 determined by the sheriff's department. Whenever Racquel Jean-Louis terminates employment
- 8 with the sheriff's department or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in
- 9 the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank.
