**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to expunged records.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (4) of subsection (a) of section 100I of chapter 276 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
3 word “commissioner;” in line 18, the following words:-
4 provided, however, multiple offenses arising out of the same incident shall be considered
5 a single offense for the purposes of this paragraph;
