An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Paula Euber, an employee of the Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for Paula Euber, an employee of the Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Department of  
2   Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission shall establish a sick leave bank for Paula Euber, an  
3   employee of the Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission. Any employee of the  
4   Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission may voluntarily contribute 1 or more  
5   sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by Paula Euber. If Paula Euber  
6   terminates employment with the Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission or  
7   requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be  
8   transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for  
9   absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave  
10  bank as determined by the Department of Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.
