Decker (with the approval of the city council) for legislation to authorize the city of Cambridge to allow for an exemption from taxation of personal property not in excess of \$20,000 of value. An Act authorizing the city of Cambridge to allow for a personal property tax exemption of \$20,000 or less.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws or any other
2 general or special law to the contrary, the city of Cambridge shall be permitted to allow for
3 exemption from taxation of personal property not in excess of \$20,000 of value.

4 SECTION 2. The city council of the city of Cambridge shall vote to establish a minimum
5 value of personal property subject to taxation. Said value shall be subject to the limitations
6 contained in section 1.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by majority vote of the city
8 council of the city of Cambridge.
