An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Leicester as the John J. Binienda memorial bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. The bridge No. L-06-017, on Rawson Street in the Town of Leicester shall be  
2 designated and known as the John J. Binienda Memorial Bridge, in memory of John J. Binienda,  
3 (June 22, 1947- August 22, 2014,) who served in the Massachusetts House of Representatives  
4 from 1986 until 2014, representing the Worcester 17th District.

5           Section 2. The Town shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in  
6 compliance with the standards of the department; or take any other action in relation thereto.
