In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Leicester as the Private First-Class Eugene Joseph Paranteau memorial bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Bridge No. #L-06-011, on Church Street in the Town of Leicester shall be

- 2 designated and known as the Private First Class Eugene Joseph Paranteau Memorial Bridge, in
- 3 memory of Private First-Class Eugene Paranteau (August 10, 1924-June 7, 1945). Private
- 4 Paranteau, a member of the U.S. Army, 2nd Platoon, Company B, 1st Battalion, 164th Infantry
- 5 Regiment, American Division, XI Corps, Eighth Army was killed in action, with his body not
- 6 recovered, on Thursday, June 7, 1945, on Negros Island, Philippines.
- 7 Section 2. The Town shall erect and maintain suitable markers bearing the designation in
- 8 compliance with the standards of the department; or take any other action in relation thereto.
