An Act amending the charter of the Town of North Andover Town Meeting Warrant Posting.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The charter of the town of North Andover, which is on file in the office of  
2 the archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the General  
3 Laws, is hereby amended in section 2-2-3 of chapter 2 by striking out the words “public place in  
4 every precinct” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- on the Town website, Town  
5 Hall, the public library, the senior center and the police station.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
