By Representatives Minicucci of North Andover and Nguyen of Andover, a petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 4904) of Christina A. Minicucci and Bruce E. Tarr (by vote of the town) that Richard Bruno, Daniel Smart and Michael Soltys shall be eligible for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of North Andover. Public Service. The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act exempting Richard Bruno, Daniel Smart and Michael Soltys from the maximum age requirement for firefighters in the Town of North Andover.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or

2 special law to the contrary, Richard Bruno, Daniel Smart and Michael Soltys shall be eligible to

3 have their names certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of

4 North Andover, notwithstanding having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service

5 examination in connection with that appointment. Richard Bruno, Daniel Smart and Michael

6 Soltys shall be eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of North

7 Andover provided that they meet all other requirements for certification and appointment to this

8 position.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
