(2019-2020)

An Act relative to insurance proceeds for injured police and fire personnel in the town of Boylston.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 53 of chapter 44 of the General Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, insurance proceeds received by the town of Boylston or any officer or department thereof to compensate a police officer or firefighter injured in the line of duty may be made available by the town to the fire or police department without specific appropriation as an offset for payments made to a police officer or firefighter pursuant to section 111 F of chapter 41 of the General Laws.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
