An Act pertaining to liquor licenses in the town of Brookline.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (A) Section 1 Paragraph (b)(1) of Chapter 268 of the Acts of 2018 is hereby
2 amended by striking out the word “Three” and inserting in place thereof the following word –
3 “Four”.

4 (B) Section 1 Paragraph (b)(2) of Chapter 268 of the Acts of 2018 is hereby amended by
5 striking out the word “Five” and inserting in place thereof the following word – “Six”.

6 (C) Section 1 Paragraph (b)(4) of Chapter 268 of the Acts of 2018 is hereby amended by
7 striking out the word “Three” and inserting in place thereof the following word – “One”.

8 (D) Section 1 Paragraph (f) of Chapter 268 of the Acts of 2018 is hereby amended by
9 striking out the number “2” and inserting in place thereof the following number – “4”.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
