Muradian, Jr., and Michael O. Moore (by vote of the town) that the town of Upton be authorized to create the office of appointed treasurer/collector. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act creating in the town of Upton the office of appointed treasurer/collector.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be
2 the office of Treasurer/Collector in the town of Upton. The Treasurer/Collector shall be
3 appointed and may be removed by the Town Manager. The Treasurer/Collector shall have all the
4 powers, perform the duties and be subject to the liabilities and penalties now or hereafter
5 conferred and imposed by law on Treasurers and Collectors. The Town Manager may establish
6 an employment contract with the Treasurer/Collector not to exceed 5 years, for salary, fringe
7 benefits and other conditions of employment, including, but not limited to, severance pay,
8 reimbursement for expense incurred in the performance of the duties of the office, liability
9 insurance, and conditions of discipline, termination, dismissal, reappointment, performance
10 standards and leave.

11 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 1, the elected incumbent holding office as of the
12 effective date of this act shall serve out the remainder of his elected term, at which time the

13 elected office shall be abolished. The elected incumbent holding office as of the effective date of
14 this act shall then become the first appointed Treasurer/Collector, and shall serve as such until
15 his resignation, retirement or removal for cause. In such case, or if the elected incumbent vacates
16 the office prior to the end of his term or the effective date of this act, appointments to the
17 position of Treasurer/Collector shall be made by the Town Manager in accordance with said
18 section 1.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
