The committee on Mental Health, Substance Use and Recovery, to whom were referred the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1699) of Ruth B. Balsler and others for legislation to provide that network hospitals be compensated for behavioral health services to certain MassHealth patients; the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1709) of Marjorie C. Decker and Carlos González relative to enabling physician assistants to authorize psychiatric and substance abuse holds; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1716) of Thomas A. Golden, Jr., for legislation to promote high value and evidence-based behavioral health care, reports the accompanying order (House, No. 5097) ought to be adopted.

5 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
6 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
