2 authorized to sit during a recess of the General Court to make an investigation and study of
3 House document numbered 1724, relative to mental health examination process of inmates at

6 and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
7 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the House of Representatives
8 on or before December 31, 2020.
