An Act relative to consumer protection on online automobile franchise transactions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 48 of Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting at the end thereof the following subsection:-

3           L. This section shall not apply to a transaction for the sale of a new or used motor vehicle  
4 by a seller holding a Class 1 license pursuant to section 59 of chapter 140 in which the buyer  
5 signs by electronic means away from the seller’s place of business a written contract regarding  
6 the sale of a motor vehicle.
