An Act relative to medical specialty camp medication administration.

*Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith medical specialty camp medication administration, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the department of public  
2 health, pursuant to its authority under subsection (g) of section 7 of chapter 94C of the General  
3 Laws, shall promulgate regulations to allow: (i) student nurses and recently graduated student  
4 nurses, as included in the definition of “nurse” in section 1 of said chapter 94C; (ii) medical  
5 specialty camp staff trained under the supervision of a practitioner as defined in section 1 of said  
6 chapter 94C; and (iii) certified diabetes care and education specialists in good standing with the  
7 Certification Board for Diabetes Education and Care, to administer medication to campers at  
8 medical specialty camps as defined in the state sanitary code.
