An Act creating assignment levels in the Department of Early Education and Care.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 7 of Chapter 15D of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "facility" in line 9, the following sentences :-  
3 Subject to appropriation, the commissioner shall ensure that no licensor shall have assignment  
4 levels of day care centers or family day care homes in excess of the standards set forth by the  
5 National Association for the Education of Young Children. Reasonable assignment levels shall  
6 be established for residential and placement licensors and investigators in order to provide  
7 adequate protection and quality care for children in licensed facilities.
