An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Karl Schneider, an employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission.

Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Massachusetts Rehabilitation
- 2 Commission shall establish a sick leave bank for Karl Schneider, an employee of the
- 3 Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission. Any employee of the Massachusetts Rehabilitation
- 4 Commission may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick
- 5 leave bank for use by Karl Schneider. If Karl Schneider terminates employment with the
- 6 Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any
- 7 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the extended illness leave bank. Sick
- 8 leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
