In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to special education funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 44 the number "4"
- and inserting in place thereof the number "3"; and further by striking in line 51 the number "4"
- 4 and inserting in place thereof the number "3."
