**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act to expand access to voter registration.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 33A of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following sentence:-

3 “The state secretary shall post the electronic document in English, Spanish and
4 Portuguese and in such additional languages as the secretary deems necessary or as required by
5 law.”.

6 SECTION 2. Section 36 of chapter 51 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
7 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 10, the words “and Spanish” and
8 inserting in place thereof the following words:- “, Spanish and Portuguese”.
