**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act supporting parents running for public office.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6 of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the word “office”, in line 66 the
3 following:-

4 or expenses relating to the provision of child care services.

5 SECTION 2. The director of the office of campaign and political finance shall
6 promulgate rules and regulations to implement this act no later than December 31, 2020.
