An Act relative to the import, sale, trade, distribution, possession, and release of marbled crayfish and marmokrebs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 37B of Chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “fleas” in line 8, the following: “,  
3 marbled crayfish and marmokrebs,”.

4           SECTION 2: Section 37B of Chapter 21 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
5 official edition, is hereby amended by adding after subsection (j) the following subsection:

6           “(k) The department shall promulgate rules and regulations regarding the import, sale,  
7 trade, distribution, possession, and release of marbled crayfish and marmokrebs within the  
8 Commonwealth. The department shall promulgate rules and regulations prohibiting the release of  
9 marbled crayfish and marmokrebs into sewage systems and local waters, including but not  
10 limited to rivers, lakes, streams, reservoirs, and coastal waters.”
