Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Chapter 131 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:-
- 3 Section 119. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no person,
- 4 except as provided in sections four, thirty-seven, and thirty-eight, shall erect, set, use, locate,
- 5 repair, tend, bait or maintain any trap, net or snare for the purpose of taking or killing any bird or
- 6 mammal within three hundred feet from a public roadway, pathway or trail.
- Any trap, net or snare may not be erected, used, tended, baited or in any other way
- 8 maintained for a period exceeding seven consecutive days, except as provided in said sections
- 9 four, thirty-seven, and thirty-eight.
