**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act modernizing Lottery payment options.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
2 is hereby amended by striking the word “agents”, in line 17, and inserting in place thereof the
3 following words:-

4 “agents; provided, further, that said restriction shall not govern the transmittal of lottery
5 information and sales for the purpose of facilitating point of sale transactions”
