An Act relative to fee waivers for registered nurses after retirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 74 of chapter 112 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-

3           In the case of a registered nurse who has retired from regular practice after 40 or more  
4 years so registered, but who desires to use the title registered nurse for the purpose of volunteer  
5 events, community emergencies, or other similar circumstances, and who is otherwise qualified  
6 to be registered with such title and is up to date with continuing education requirements, the  
7 board shall waive any fees associated with registration under this section.
