*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION XX. Subsection (c) of section 5A of chapter 71B of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 44 the number "4"
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the number "3"; and further by striking in line 51.
