The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act providing the next of kin of a police officer or firefighter killed in the line of duty with the flags of the Commonwealth and the United States.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 89E the following section:-
- 3 Section 89F. If a sworn police officer of a police department of city or town, a sworn
- 4 police officer of the department of state police or a firefighter for a fire department of a city or
- 5 town, is killed, or dies from injuries received, or dies as a natural or proximate result of
- 6 undergoing a hazard peculiar to his or her employment, while in the performance of his or her
- duty, their next of kin shall receive a flag of the commonwealth of Massachusetts and a flag of
- 8 the United States during the memorial service, the cost of which shall be borne by the
- 9 commonwealth.
