An Act relative to excise tax repayments.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 2A of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official  
2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding to the end, the following paragraph:-

3           Municipalities may adopt installment repayment plans for excise tax. If a municipality  
4 adopts such an installment plan, the municipality shall transmit to the registrar, in such form as  
5 approved by the registrar, the name and address of any person enrolled in an installment plan  
6 forthwith. The payment plan shall serve as a legal notice to the registrar that the matter has been  
7 disposed of in accordance of the law.
