**In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court
(2019-2020)**

An Act relative to equitable regional transit authority funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 35T of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3 (c) Notwithstanding the foregoing, nine-tenths of the certified dedicated sales tax
4 revenue amount shall be credited to the Fund on behalf of the authority and the remaining one-
5 tenth of said amount shall be credited to the Fund for disbursement on behalf of the regional
6 transit authorities established in chapter 161B.

7 SECTION 2. Section 1 shall take effect as of July 1, 2019.
