An Act exempting veterans from the standard registration fee for veterans license plates.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the Generals Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 539, the following new paragraph:-

3 The registrar shall furnish, upon application, to owners of private passenger motor  
4 vehicles and motorcycles who are veterans, as defined in clause Forty-third of section 7 of  
5 chapter 4 and upon presentation of evidence deemed satisfactory by the registrar, distinctive  
6 registration plates bearing on the left side the word "VETERAN". The registrar shall waive the  
7 initial registration fee of \$60 and for each subsequent renewal.
